1. Unpacking.

Your Mission EP1-L6 expression pedal box includes the pedal and a hex key for adjusting the tension of the pedal. Keep this key as you may need to adjust the tension of your pedal in future.

2. Connecting.

The Mission EP1-L6 is designed for connection to the expression pedal interface on supported Line 6 products. Check the specific Line 6 documentation for the location of the expression pedal input jack. It is normally marked EXPRESSION PEDAL or PEDAL 2. Connect the PEDAL OUT jack on the Mission EP1-L6 to the pedal input on the equipment using a standard ¼" mono instrument cable. A guitar cable or effects patch cable will work fine. The Mission EP1-L6 does not require a stereo (TRS) cable. The Mission EP1-L6 is designed to be connected to supported Line 6 equipment only, and not to expression pedal inputs on devices from other manufacturers.

3. Using.

The Mission EP1-L6 is a plug and play device. There is nothing to configure on the pedal itself. Follow the instructions in your Line 6 user guide to assign the pedal to control the effect(s) of your choice. Move the pedal to heel down for minimum effect, and toe down for maximum effect. If necessary, the tension of the pedal can be adjusted using the hex key provided. The tension adjuster is located at the rear of the pedal underneath the treadle. Insert the hex key and tighten to increase the stiffness of the pedal, or loosen to reduce the stiffness.
