

## Start Here

### 1. Description.

---

The Mission TT is a high quality footswitch with a ¼" instrument out jack. The Mission TT can be used as an external switch for channel switching, tap tempo, and Instant Access functions depending on the device it is connected to. There are two versions of the Mission TT switch; the Mission TT-M is a momentary switch, and the Mission TT-L is a latching switch. The TT-M can be identified by the mini toggle switch located on the side, opposite the output jack. The TT-L has no toggle switch.

### 2. Connecting.

---

The Mission TT-M should be connected to the device with a standard mono (TS) ¼" instrument cable such as a guitar cable or effect patch cable. The Mission TT-L should be connected with a stereo (TRS) cable.

### 3. Using.

---

Press down on the footswitch to activate. The footswitch can be pressed repeatedly for tap tempo functions.

The Mission TT-M is configurable via the toggle switch to 'normally open' or 'normally closed'. The default is normally open, which is the toggle switch in the down position. This is compatible with most devices. If your device requires normally closed operation, switch the toggle to the up position.
