1. Description.

The Mission XPB is an eXpression Pedal in a Box. The XPB can be connected to the expression pedal input on a controller, processor or effects pedal. Turning the knob left to right has the same effect as moving an expression pedal up and down.

2. Connecting.

The standard Mission XPB should be connected to the expression pedal input of the effects unit using a ¼" stereo (TRS) instrument cable. The XPB-L6 model is intended only for use with effects units and processors from Line 6. the XPB-L6 should be connected to the pedal input of the Line 6 device using a standard ¼" mono (TS) instrument cable such as a guitar or patch cable.

3. Using.

The Mission XPB is fitted with a rubber boot that can be used to turn the adjustment knob by hand or by foot. Turning the knob fully left (counter clockwise) is the same as an expression pedal in heel down. Turning the knob fully right (clockwise) is the same as an expression pedal in toe down. The rubber boot may be removed for normal hand operation if preferred.
